

Announcements and Old Business – President Jane Cecelic

- By June 1 waterfront homeowners will have received individual work documents and will have until June 15 to return approved documents for permitting by August. Dredging is scheduled to begin this fall.
- Harbor Lane homeowners have separate permitting process but should be able to get their work done at the same time as Baycliff's.
- Approximately \$126,000 in pledge account now. 36 households due to give remaining pledges by June 1 totaling approximately \$29,000. Second spur channel is now funded.
- Next dredging meeting will take place the beginning of June to look at the final channel design.
- Fire hydrant in entrance circle has been damaged. Jane will check with homeowners to see if the city has been notified, if not she will inform city of damage.
- Sanitary sewer work is scheduled to begin the second week of June and will take a year and a half to complete.
- Steve Zahn requested that Civic League members send him ideas for future meeting topics.
- Jane Cecelic was thanked for her service as Civic League president and she will move on to work on the dredging project.
