Opening

Mike Perry called the regular meeting of the Baycliff Civic League to order at 7:05 p.m. in the library of Alanton Elementary School

- Electricians added receptacles on both walls for \$700
- Bulkhead repairs are waiting on the report from the surveyor. He needs the soundings to finish the report, which he will likely take from the bulkhead. Same contractor as drone survey
- Dave suggested posting a no parking sign at the boat ramp. A lady in her mid-twenties parks on the street side of the chain and blocks the ramp so she can walk her dog. When Dave has approached her, she says, "We're members here" and refuses to move her vehicle. If she has a key, it is baffling why she would not just park in the lot. Dave has called the police about this and they said there is nothing they can do. The board said we would consider adding a sign and asked Dave to get her license plate. From there, we can look into whether she is a resident and may need to get Sharon Herring involved.
- Wayne & Pat met with a consultant representing the developer west of the boat ramp before last meeting about putting piers in the waterway. Pat asked them to provide a simple sketch of their proposed plan but we have not heard anything back as of this month's meeting. Pat suggested the League consider offering boat ramp keys to the residents across the way.
- Pat will write something for the Bugle once the estimate(s) arrive
- Discussion of the street light vegetation concluded with suggesting Wayne reach out to the residents listed in last month's minutes to suggest they trim back their trees to allow the streets to be safely lit

- Steve Zahn continues to work on taxes.
